I. Popakademie Baden-Württemberg

With its degree programmes and unique combination of music and business practice, the Popakademie Baden-Württemberg stands out among higher education institutions. IV. Nomination and application procedure

Please note that the home institution, e.g. International Office/Coordinator, must nominate students. The Popakademie does not have an online application service (yet!). Nominations can be send via e-mail with the following information: name, date of birth, e-mail address, study programme and main subject and current academic year. The nominated students will receive an application form from the Popakademie coordinator in order to complete their application.

Important: Exchange students can only apply for winter terms. Once here, there is the possibility of extending the exchange for another semester. The extension needs to be discussed with the responsible Degree Programme Administrator and the Manager Internationalization.

V. Housing

a. Student Housing

The Studierendenwerk Mannheim provides student housing in Mannheim. Please note that the Studierendenwerk is not part of our institution and operates independently from us.

of sufficient insurance coverage from a company in their home country or need to sign up with a German health insurance company. Please check with your insurance company prior to arrival if you have the necessary coverage for your stay in Germany.

VIII. Baden-Württemberg-STIPENDIUM

The Baden-Württemberg-STIPENDIUM is a scholarship programme, which supports young people from Baden-Württemberg to spend some time abroad and invites foreign scholarship holders to get to know Baden-Württemberg and their host institutions. When placement is confirmed, each foreign scholarship holder receives a grant of at least 700 EUR per month for a minimum of 3 months during the stay. The Baden-Württemberg-STIPENDIUM is only granted to students who do not receive any other funding through scholarships, e.g. Erasmus+. Application deadline is March 31 of each year.
